Future – going to



Uso:



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El tiempo futuro con la estructura **be + going to** se usa para hablar de un futuro cercano y que puede suceder.

- Tomorrow, **I'm going to** study for my exam.
- **I'm going to** travel to Veracruz on Saturday.
- Tonight, my brother **is going to** play soccer with his friends.
- We **aren't going to** have classes on Friday.
- **Is she going to** do exercise today in the afternoon?





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Estructura:

Para formar esta estructura, se utiliza el verbo **to be** en presente simple más la estructura **going to** más el verbo correspondiente en su forma simple:

To be

verbo forma simple

Am

study

Is + going to

+ work

Are

read

Ejemplos:

I'm **going to study** Biology next Wednesday morning.

My father **is going to work** tomorrow at 5:00.

We **are going to read** our English notes after class.



Indicadores de futuro:

- **on Friday** ➞ I'm going to go shopping **on Friday**.
- **next year** ➞ You are going to visit Cancun **next year**.
- **Tomorrow** ➞ Is he going to go swimming **tomorrow**?
- **next mont** ➞ She's going to finish her class **next month**.
- **today in the evening** ➞ I'm not going to go to a concert **today in the evening**.
- **next weekend** ➞ **Next weekend**, we are going to have a party at home

I am not going to play soccer.

You aren't going to play soccer.

He isn't going to play soccer.

Forma interrogativa:



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Am I going to play soccer?

Where are going to play soccer.

He isn't going to play soccer.

She isn't going to play soccer.

We aren't going to play soccer.

They aren't going to play soccer.
