Para expresar una **promesa** en inglés, utilizamos el verbo auxiliar **will** :

- ⊙ I promise you I **will take** you to the movies next weekend.
- ⊙ The president **will finish** the new road next year, his secretary informed.
- ⊙ My mother, father, sister and me **will go** on vacation to Monterrey next year if we get good grades at school.

Predicciones:

Igualmente, al hacer predicciones a futuro, utilizamos el auxiliar **will** :

- ✓ In year 2050, solar energy **will be** very common in houses.
- ✓ Computers **will receive** voice commands in the future and **won't be** necessary to type.
- ✓ In 70 years, it **won't be** necessary to go shopping.
Supermarkets **will send** their groceries to our houses.
