# THERE IS

- There is a flower vase on the table



- There is a bottle of wine in the fridge



- Singular Countable noun

# THERE ARE

- There are three lamps in the living room



- There're five people at the table



- Plural countable noun

# There's - there're

- There's **some orange** juice in the jar



- Uncountable noun

- There're **many students** in the classroom



- Countable noun

# There is not – There isn't

- ◉ There is not a museum in the city
- ◉ Singular countable noun
  
- ◉ There isn't any bread
- ◉ Uncountable noun

# There are – there aren't

- ◉ There are not many computers in my school
- ◉ There aren't any plants in my garden
- ◉ Plural countable noun
