Would you like to ...?	¿Le gustaría...?	A: Would you like to drink some water? B: Yes, please.
I would like to order a ...	Me gustaría ordenar...	I would like to order a pizza.
How much is the...?	¿Cuánto es el/la...?	A: How much is the pizza? B: It's 200 pesos.
How much are the...?	¿Cuántos son las/los...?	A: How much are the books? B: They are 650 pesos.
How much does it cost?	¿Cuánto cuesta esto?	A: How much does it cost? B: It's 80 pesos.
How much is it?	¿Cuánto es?	A: Excuse, how much is it? B: It is 26 pesos.
This one.	Éste.	A: Which dress do you like better? B: This one. It is beautiful.
That one.	Aquél.	A: Which blouse do you prefer? B: That one. It is near to the window.
The red one.	El rojo.	A: Which one do you like more? B: The red one.
I'll take it.	Lo tomaré/lo llevaré	A: Do you like this blue scarf? B: Yes, I do. I'll take it. How much is it?
I'll take the red one.	Tomaré/llevaré el rojo.	A: Which hat do you prefer? B: I'll take the red one.
Here you are.	Aquí tienes.	A: The shoes are 350 pesos. B: Here you are.
May/Can I help you?	¿Puedo ayudarte?	A: Hello, may I help you? B: Yes, please.
Could/Can I try it on?	¿Me lo puedo probar?	A: Here you have the t-shirt. B: Can I try it on?
What size are you?	¿Qué talla eres?	A: What size are you? B: I am medium size.
Do you have/ can I have a larger/ smaller size?	¿Tiene/me puede traer una talla más grande/ pequeña?	A: Can I have a larger size? B: Sure.
Just looking	Solo estoy mirando	A: May I help you? B: I'm just looking.
Anything else?	¿Algo más?	A: Do you need anything else? B: No, I don't. Thank you.
Pay by credit card/ debit card/ check/ in cash	Pagar con tarjeta de crédito/ tarjeta de débito/ con cheque/ en efectivo	I'll pay in cash.

I'll buy/ pay/ have	Yo compraré/ pagaré/ llevaré	I'll buy a t-shirt. I'll pay by debit card. I'll have a coffee, please.
Can I use the restroom?	¿Puedo usar el baño?	A: Can I use the restroom? B: Of course.
Can I have glass of water, please?	¿Me podría traer un vaso de agua? Por favor.	A: Can I have a glass of water, please? B: Sure.
There are few people in the restaurant.	Hay pocas personas en el restaurante.	There are few people in the restaurant.
How many...?	¿Cuántos/ cuántas?	A: How many hamburgers do you want? B: Two, please.

Dollar	Dólar	I save dollars in the bank.
Franc	Franco	The only country that uses francs is Switzerland.
Pound (£)	Libra	In England you need to use pounds , no pesos.
Euro (€)	Euro	The euro is in 21 pesos.
