



En esta unidad practicamos cómo...

A Saludar y decir nuestros nombres y apellidos:

Juan: Hello! **I'm** Juan. What's **your** name?
 Celia: Hi! **My** name is Celia. Nice to meet you, Juan.
 Juan: Nice to meet you, too, Celia.

Recuerda que.... 😊

- La expresión "Nice to meet you." Se dice al conocer a una persona.
 Y se responde "Nice to meet you, **too**."

C Preguntar y dar nuestra ocupación:

Celia: What's **your** occupation?
 Juan: **I** am a student.
 Celia: What's **your** major?
 Juan: **I** study Management. How about **your** major?
 Celia: **I** am **an** Administration student.

😊 ¿Recuerdas la diferencia entre **a** y **an**?

La expresión "How about your...?" significa "¿Y el tuyo?"

Recuerda que.... 😊

Para preguntar la **ocupación** puedes utilizar cualquiera de esta preguntas:

- What's **your** occupation? *I am a student.*
- What's **your** job? *I am an Administration student.*
- What **do you** do? *I'm an English teacher.*

B Deletrear nuestros nombres y apellidos:

J: What's **your** last name, Celia?
 C: Lopez
 J: How do **you** spell it?
 C: L-O-P-E-Z. Lopez.

Recuerda que.... 😊

First name = nombre
 Last name = apellido
 Full name = nombre completo
 Nick name = nombre de cariño (apodo)

D Preguntar y dar nuestro teléfono:

C: What's **your** phone number, Juan?
 J: It's 7-2-5 5-3-5-0 And yours?
 C: 7-1-3-4-5-8-8

Recuerda que.... 😊

- Los números se dicen de uno en uno y el **0** (cero) se dice [ou]
- Cuando hay un número repetido, se dice "double".
Ejemplo: "88" = "double eight"
- "And yours?" Significa "¿Y el tuyo?" para no repetir la pregunta

E Preguntar y decir nuestro origen, nacionalidad e idioma

B: Where are **you** from, Ana?
 A: **I'm** from Puebla. What's **your** nationality, Bill?
 B: **I'm** Canadian.
 A: What languages do **you** speak, Bill?
 B: **I** speak French and English.

F Preguntar y decir nuestro estado civil:

A: Are **you** married, Bill??
 B: No. **I'm** single. And you, Ana?
 A: **I'm** divorced.

married = casad@ single = solter@
 divorced = divorciad@

G Preguntar y decir nuestra edad:

A: How old are **you**, Bill?

B: **I'm** twenty one years old. or **I'm** twenty one.

😊 ¿Recuerdas la diferencia entre **you** y **your**?

You = Tú o Usted o Ustedes. Ejemplos:

-**You** are a student.

-**You** are from Orizaba.

-**You** are 19 years old.

Your = tu (de pertenencia). Ejemplos:

-**Your** name is Estela.

-**Your** address is 34 Independence Avenue.

-**Your** telephone number is 7-1-2-3-4-5-6.

H Preguntar y dar nuestro domicilio:

A: What's **your** address, Bill?

B: It's 1248 Madero Street.

😊 Ten presente como se dice el número en una dirección.

-Si son de cuatro dígitos, se pronuncia de dos en dos: **1248** (twelve-forty eight).

-Si son tres dígitos: **318** (three-eighteen).

-Si son cuatro dígitos con un cero antes del último número: **1306** (thirteen-ou-six).

-Si son tres dígitos con un cero en medio: **507** (five-ou-seven).

I Preguntar y dar nuestro correo electrónico:

A: What's **your** e-mail, Bill?

B: **My** e-mail is bill28@gmail.com.

😊 Ten presente el vocabulario utilizado para dar correo electrónico:

@ = at _ = underscore - = hyphen . = dot

Recuerda que.... 😊

Estas mismas preguntas se pueden hacer para todas las personas, solamente tener cuidado con el **pronombre sujeto** y con el **adjetivo posesivo** que se utilizarán. Además distinguir **género** (masculino, femenino o ambos) y **número** (singular y plural): **Ejemplos:**

Preguntas acerca de una **persona femenina:**

What's **her** name? **Her** name is Dora.

What's **her** last name? **Her** last name is Torres.

What's **her** occupation? { **She** is a teacher.

What does **she** do?

What's **her** nationality? **She's** Canadian.

Where is **she** from? **She's** from Toronto.

What languages does **she** speak? **She** speaks French, English and Japanese.

Is **she** married? Yes, **she** is.

How old is **she**? **She** is 28.

What's **her** phone number? **Her** phone number is 234-778507.

What's **her** address? **Her** address is 1234 Greenish Avenue.

What's **her** e-mail? **Her** e-mail is dorisAB@yahoo.com.



Preguntas acerca de una **persona masculina:**

What's **his** name? **His** name is David.

What's **his** last name? **His** last name is Sanchez.

What's **his** occupation? { **He** is a student.

What does **he** do?

What's **his** nationality? **He's** Peruvian.

Where is **he** from? **He's** from Lima.

What languages does **he** speak? **He** speaks Chinese, English and Spanish.

Is **he** married? No, **he** is not. **He's** single.

How old is **he**? **He** is 18.

What's **his** phone number? **His** phone is 245-998503.

What's **his** address? **His** address is 304 Penguin Street.

What's **his** e-mail? **His** e-mail is divad34@hotmail.com.

What are **your** names? **Our** names are Diana and Betty.

What's **your** last name? **Our** last name is Mendez.

What's **your** occupation? **We** are students.

What do **you** do?

What's **your** nationality? **We** are Mexican.

Where are **you** from? **We** are from Veracruz.

What languages do **you** speak? **We** speak Nahuatl, English and Spanish.

Are **you** married? No, **we** aren't. **We** are single.

How old are **you**? **She** is 16 and **I** am 19.

What's **your** phone number? **Our** phone number is 234-72.

What's **your** address? **Our** address is 348 Colón Avenue.

What's **your** e-mail? **Her** e-mail is anaidyy@yahoo.com and **my** e-mail is bett32@yahoo.com.mx.



Preguntas acerca de **dos personas**:

What are **their** names? **Their** names are Vero and Bernard.

What's **their** last name? **Their** last name is Morrison.

What's **their** occupation? **She** is a nurse and **he** is a doctor.

What do **they** do? **They** are layers.

What's **their** nationality? **They** are American.

Where are **they** from? **They** are from Texas.

What languages do **they** speak? **They** speak English and Spanish.

Are **they** married? Yes, **they** are.

How old are **they**? **She** is 28 and **he** is 34.

What's **their** phone number? **Their** phone number is 555-9986.

What's **their** address? **Their** address is 348 Golden Avenue.

What's **their** e-mail? **Her** e-mail is veromor@gmail.com and **his** e-mail is bermor@yahoo.com.

You are Mexican.

Adjetivos **posesivos**

My name is Roberto.

Your name is Rodrigo.

Her office is in Cordoba.

His last name is Uribe.

Our favorite music is pop.

Your favorite actors are Gee and Joe.

Their names are Joe and Juliet.



Recuerda....

La conjugación del verbo **TO BE**

I am

You are

She is

He is

It is

We are

You are

They are

El verbo **TO BE** tiene significado diferente acorde al contexto:

I am a student. = Yo **soy** estudiante.

I am 18 years old. = Yo **tengo** 18 años.

I am married. = Yo **estoy** casado.
