How old is she?	She is <b>23</b> years old
Where is she from ?	she is from <b>Puebla</b>
What's she like?	She is <b>nice, friendly and beautiful</b>

Si te preguntan de un hombre las preguntas son iguales, pero en lugar de "she" dirías "he" , en lugar de "her name" dirías "his name"

Peter: Say, Jenny What's your mother doing right now?  
Jenny: She is cooking. She is making spaghetti and a salad.  
Peter: mmm sounds delicious! What is your sister doing?  
Jenny: She is studying. She is having an exam tomorrow  
Peter: Is your brother working?  
Jenny: Yes, he is . He is very happy  
Peter: where is he working?  
Jenny: He is working in a restaurant. He is a chef.  
Peter: Well, Jenny I have to go now. I am going to a conference. Bye, take care.  
Jenny: Bye. Take care

Where do you live? I live in Poza Rica  
Donde vives?

Do you live in a house or an apartment? I live in a house  
(Vives en una casa o apartamento?)

Is your house(apartment) in the city, the country or the suburbs? It's in the suburbs  
(Esta tu casa en la ciudad, el campo los suburbios?)

Is it big or small? It's small  
(Es grande o pequeño?)

How many rooms does it have? It has 2 bedrooms, 2 bathrooms, a kitchen and a living room  
(Cuantos cuartos tiene?)

What's your favorite room? My bedroom  
(Cual es tu cuarto favorito?)

What's in your bedroom? A bed, a lamp, a mirror, a TV and a computer  
(que hay en tu cuarto?)

Does your house have a yard? Yes, it does / no, it doesn't  
( tu casa tiene patio?)

(A que hora terminas de trabajar?)

Is your job difficult? Yes, it is /No, it isn't  
(tu trabajo es difícil?)

How do you like your job? I love my job ! / I hate my job  
(Que tanto te gusta tu trabajo?) :) :(

What do you do after work? I go home and relax  
(Que haces después del trabajo?)

Where do you eat \*breakfast? At school  
(donde desayunas?)

What's your favorite food? Mexican food  
(cual es tu comida favorita?)

What is your favorite restaurant? VIPS  
(cual es tu restaurante favorito?)

Do you like VEGETABLES? Yes, I do / No, I don't  
(te gustan los vegetales?)

En lugar de "breakfast", también podrías decir "lunch" o "dinner"
