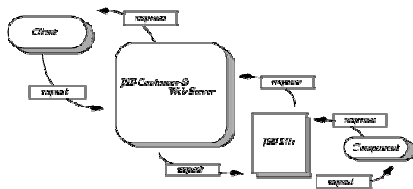

Using special tags

- `<jsp:useBean>` tag to create or locate an instance of the bean
- `<jsp:setProperty>` tag to set properties in the bean from the HTML form (the bean needs a matching set method).
- `<jsp:getProperty>` tag to retrieve the data from the bean (the bean needs a matching get method).
