Waiter/Waitress	May/Can I help you? Do you need any help? Can I offer you a glass of water?	
offer your help/service	Would you like anything else? Anything else? Would you like to order (some dessert)?  A table for how many people? Are you paying in cash/by credit card?	
	Here you are	
Client	Can I have a vanilla milkshake, please? Can I try the red wine?	
ask for food/drinks/services?	I'm not ready to order, give me one more minute. I'd like to order a steak with salad. I want some bread, please. I'll have a bowl of soup.	
	Can I use the restroom?
