When you are **shopping at stores** and as a **client/customer** you want to ask for cost, sizes, colors, or as a **salesperson** you want to offer some help, you have options:

If you want to...	Singular (1 product/item)	Plural (2 or more products/items)
Client ...ask for prices/cost?	1) How much is this red sweater? 2) How much does that dress cost?	3) How much are the jeans on the shelf? 4) How much do the brown shoes cost?
Salesperson ...give information about prices/cost	1) This one is \$680.00, the white one is \$1200.00 2) The blue one costs \$889.00.	3) They are on sale, they're only \$260.00. 4) These ones cost \$1430.00.
Client ...ask for information about the product/item?	1) Can I have the white one in size M, please? 2) Can I try it on? 1) 2) Can I have a larger size?	3) Can you give me the jeans on sale? 4) Do you have them in black? 3) 4) I want to try them on.
Salesperson ...offer your help/service	Can I help you? What size are you? Here you are .	Do you need any help? What size do you need? The changing rooms are over there.
Client ...buy the items you want	1) I'll take the white one, please. 2) I'll buy it, and pay in cash.	3) I'll take those jeans over there. I'll pay by credit card. 4) I want them please, I'll pay by check.

If you want to...	
<b>Waiter/Waitress</b>  ...offer your help/service	May/Can I help you?    Do you need any help?    Can I offer you a glass of water?  Would you like anything else?    Anything else?    Would you like to order (some dessert)?  A table for how many people?    Are you paying in cash/by credit card?  Here you are
<b>Client</b>  ...ask for food/drinks/services?	Can I have a vanilla milkshake, please?    Can I try the red wine?  I'm not ready to order, give me one more minute.    I'd like to order a steak with salad. I want some bread, please.    I'll have a bowl of soup.  Can I use the restroom?
