

SIMPLE PAST TENSE Irregular verbs **Regular verbs** visit -visited speak-spoke clean- cleaned come-came study-studied read-read AFIRMATIVE **AFIRMATIVE** I walked two kilometers yesterday She spoke english in class. David studied english 2 years ago. He came home tonight. INTERROGATIVE **INTERROGATIVE** Did you walk two kilometers? Did she speak english in class? Did David study english 2 years ago? Did he come home tonight? **NEGATIVE NEGATIVE** I didn't walk two kilometers yesterday. She didn't speak english in class. David didn't study english. He didn't come home tonight
