## Tema 7 There is, there are

Lengua 1

### Affirmative with singular nouns.

There is a sofa in the living room.

There is an armchair in the living room.

(There + be+ article + singular noun + complement)

★ Para sustantivos que empiezan con sonido vocal usa **an** + noun.

There is **some** **money** in my pocket.

(There + be + some + noncount noun + complement)

★ Con los sustantivos incontables, usa **some**+ sustantivo.

Some=algunos, algunas.

### Affirmative with plural nouns

There    are    some    chairs    in the dining room

(There + be + some + count noun + complement)

★ Usa **some** para sustantivos contables plural.





## Tema 7 There is, there are

Lengua 1

### Negative with singular nouns.

There isn't a sofa.

(There is + not + a + count noun)  
(neg.)

There isn't any sugar in my  
coffee.

(There + is + not + any + noncount noun +  
(incontable))

★ Puedes usar **any** con sustantivos  
incontables.

Otra forma de decirlo:

There is no sofa in the living room.

(There + be + no + count  
noun+complement)

★ En esta oración no necesitas el artículo  
“a” junto al  
sustantivo.



## Tema 7 There is, there are

Lengua 1

### Negative with plural nouns.

★ Hay dos formas:

(contraction)

There aren't any lamps ...  
(There + be+not + any + plural noun  
(neg.)

in the living room. (complement)



Usa **any** para oraciones negativas e interrogativas.



O bien solo así:

There are no lamps

There be + no + plural noun.







## Tema 7 There is, there are

Lengua 1

### Interrogative with singular nouns.

Is there a coffee table in the living room?

(Is+ there + article + sing. count noun)

Yes, there **is a** coffee table. (Affirmative)

No, there **isn't a** coffee table. (Negative)

★ Usa el artículo **a** para sustantivos en singular contables.

### Interrogative with plural nouns

**Are** there any curtains...?

Be + there+ any+ count noun

Yes, there **are some** curtains. (Aff.)

No, there **aren't any** curtains. (Neg.)

★ Usa **any** para oraciones interrogativas y negativas.



## Tema 7 Questions with do/does and the verb have

Lengua 1

### Interrogative form.

Does your house have a garden?

(Aux + noun + verb have + complement)

Yes, it **does**. (Aff.)

Neg. No, it **doesn't**. (Neg.)

} short

} answers

Yes, it **has** a garden.

No, it **doesn't have** a garden.

} Long

} answers

Do the bedrooms have any closets?

(Aux + noun + verb have + complement)



Use **any** en preguntas con plurals.

Yes, they do.

No, they don't.

} short

} answer

Yes, they **have** closets.

No, they **don't have any** closets.

} long

} Answer



Use **any** en forma negativa con plurals.

B: No, there aren't any chairs in the kitchen./There are no chairs in the kitchen.
