Where are the ...?	¿Dónde están las/los...?	<i>Where are the</i> museums? The museums are in the city center.
Is there a ...? There is a ...	¿Hay ahí un...? Ahí hay un...	<i>Is there a</i> coffee shop? Yes, <i>there is a coffee shop</i> two blocks away.
Are there any ...? There are...	¿Hay alguna...? Ahí hay...	<i>Are there any</i> department stores? Yes, <i>there are</i> some stores on Juan Pablo II Avenue.
It's about ... minutes from ...	Está a... minutos de...	The school is about 10 <i>minutes from</i> the mall.
How do you go to school?	¿Cómo vas a la escuela?	<i>How do you go to school?</i> By car or bicycle.
How do you go to work?	¿Cómo vas al trabajo?	<i>How do you go to work?</i> I get there by bus.

By car/ taxi/ bus	En carro / taxi / autobús	She usually gets here <i>by car</i> .

I walk to school.	Yo camino a la escuela.	I don't have a car, so <i>I walk to school</i> every morning.

I drive to school.	Manejo a la escuela.	I do not walk to school, <i>I drive to school</i> .
