Far – Farther – Farthest Further – Furthest	Lejos – Más lejano – el Más lejano	She lives far away. Her house is farther than the school. Her ranch is the farthest .
Little – Less - Least	Poco – Menos – lo Mínimo/Menos	I’m a little tired. I’m less tired than I expected. That’s the least of my problems.
Much/Many – More – Most	Mucho – Más – el/la Más	He didn’t speak much English. His sister spoke more English. Her English is the most correct in this class.
