Across from	Enfrente de (cruzando alguna calle)	Her office is <b>across from</b> the firefighter's station.
Next to	Junto a / A lado de	We live <b>next to</b> a gym.
Between	En medio / entre	Our house is <b>between</b> two buildings.
On the corner of	En la esquina de	There was an old house <b>on the corner of</b> Independencia St. <b>and</b> Arista St.
Around the corner	Doblando en la esquina / A la vuelta.	The parking lot is just <b>around the corner</b> .

Arrive	Llegar	We <b>arrive</b> tomorrow morning.
Drive	Manejar	I'm about to <b>drive</b> the truck.
Get (to)	Llegar	How did you <b>get</b> there?
Go	Ir	I have to <b>go</b> to school.
Miss	Extrañar / Fallar / Pasar por alto	I <b>miss</b> my pet, it got lost. Don't <b>miss</b> the science class.
Take	Tomar / Agarrar	Maria <b>takes</b> the bus every day.
Turn	Girar / Doblar (dar la vuelta)	<b>Turn</b> right when you get to the corner of Independencia St. <b>and</b> Arista St.
Walk	Caminar	We <b>Walk</b> around the park every Saturday.

Avenue / Ave.	Avenida	This avenue leads to your house.
Block	Cuadra	His house is two blocks ahead.
Corner	Esquina	Our house is on a corner.
Exit	Salida	Where is the exit?
Traffic lights	Semáforo	Look at the traffic lights before crossing.
Stop	Alto / Deténgase (Pare)	Stop if you see a red light.
