Reciban un cordial y respetuoso saludo. El motivo del presente es solicitar su apoyo para el siguiente caso.

Mi nombre es N3-ELIMINADO 1 matrícula S21009704. Estudiante de la facultad de Psicología Campus Veracruz, actualmente estoy cursando 5° semestre. El año pasado comencé mi trámite de movilidad acompañada con el maestro enlace de Movilidad el Dr. José Ángel Mora Ramón, dentro del periodo de la convocatoria de Movilidad 2024-1, la cual se dio inicio el 21 de Agosto del 2023 y se cerro el 21 de septiembre de dicho año.

Una vez que publicaron los resultados el 29 de septiembre, fui seleccionada en primera lista para realizar la movilidad a la Universidad a la que yo había aplicado como primera opción , La Universidad Colegio Cork, en Cork, Irlanda, por lo que inicie mi proceso de movilidad junto con la Licenciada Andrea López Bernal, Responsable de los Programas de Movilidad Internacional, así mismo, participe en reuniones vía zoom en donde se nos dio a conocer información importante, sobre la visa, los seguros médicos entre otros temas relativos acerca de nuestra movilidad.

Actualmente ya cuento los exámenes de inglés que el total fue de \$2,000 pesos mexicanos, seguido del seguro médico que cubre toda mi estancia en Cork, Irlanda el cuál tuvo un costo de \$4,142.76 pesos mexicanos , cuento con los boletos de avión (viaje redondo) que en total fue \$36,296 pesos mexicanos, sumando el airbnb donde me hospedaré 2 noches, debido a que el check -in de la residencia Estudiantil Eden Hall, que me brindará el servicio de dormitorios es a partir del 8 de Enero del 2024, no obstante yo necesito llegar unos día antes para familiarizarme con la ubicación de la escuela, medio de transporte, medio de comunicación y poner en orden todos lo necesario para el inicio de semestre y que el día 8 de enero de 2024 me entreguen la habitación , el costo del Airbnb por un par de días fue de \$2,186.42 pesos mexicanos, a esto hay que sumar el costo de la residencia estudiantil Eden Hall, que es el lugar donde me quedaré durante toda mi estancia estudiando en Irlanda que fue de €3875 que convertido al tipo de cambio en pesos es de \$72,823.09 pesos mexicanos.

Haciendo la sumatoria del total de los gastos realizados hasta el día de hoy 03/Enero/2024 es de \$117,448.27 pesos mexicanos.

Por lo anterior, recurro amablemente a ustedes para solicitar su apoyo económico por la cantidad de \$6,000 a través del Fondo Pro Mejoras de la Facultad de

Psicología para cubrir el costo de la Visa que necesito tramitar posterior a los 90 días de mi llegada a Cork, Irlanda. Dicho costo de la visa es de €300.

En caso de verme favorecida con el apoyo solicitado, adjunto la caratula de mi estado de cuenta para el depósito correspondiente, adicionalmente les comento que debido a que mi vuelo de salida a Cork es el día 05 de Enero se me haría imposible el recoger personalmente algún cheque si fuera el caso.

Sin más por el momento me reitero a sus distinguidas órdenes.


Immigration in Ireland- PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

ARRIVING TO IRELAND

ALL STUDENTS FLYING INTO IRELAND WITH A NON-EUROPEAN PASSPORT MUST REGISTER WITH IMMIGRATION

OUR SUPPORT OFFICER WILL PROVIDE IMMIGRATION REGISTRATION INFORMATION TO YOU AT ORIENTATION.

On arrival in Ireland/EU you are required to carry the following documents on your person when passing through Immigration at the Airport:

 - 1. Your Passport
 - 2. Printed UCC Letter of Acceptance.

At the airport, Immigration will stamp your passport, usually for one month - during this time you will be required to register with the Immigration Office in the Cork City Centre.

- 1. Book an appointment with the immigration office
 - 2. Bring along required documents and the completed IRP form

Our support officer will provide information on IMMIGRATION REGISTRATION to you at orientation.

To register at Immigration in Cork City Centre AFTER ARRIVAL you will require the following documentation:

An immigration information session will be held at Orientation.

1. Passport
2. Valid Visa (If applicable)- <i>Not all students are required to have a visa to fly into Ireland</i>
3. UCC ID Card (available at UCC Orientation)
4. IRP (Irish Residence Permit) Form- Click here Immigration Registration Form
5. Health Insurance (students are advised to bring copy of their private health insurance policy which states they are covered while in Ireland and hospital cover is also included – dates of coverage must be included on the policy). The students name must be on the policy.
6. Immigration Card Fee – 300 EURO (can be paid by debit/credit card)
7. Proof of Financial Support: (Non-Visa requiring countries can avail of the following options)
- Sponsorship letter from government or home institution* stating that ALL expenses are covered
OR
- A current foreign bank statement not less than one month old, together with a past statement, for an account in the student's name (as in his or her passport) accompanied by a debit card in the same name and same bank account
OR
- Bank Statement from an Irish Bank Account
8. Evidence of permanent residence in Ireland Provide FULL address, including apartment no. Normally from bank statement/lease agreement/utility bill. <i>Self-service "Letter of Attendance" from UCC portal is not acceptable proof of address for immigration purposes.</i>

UCC Checklist for First Time Registration with Immigration 2023

You do this by showing you have direct access to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • €4,500, if you are staying for more than 6 months • €700 per month or €4,500 (in total) if you are staying 6 months or less <p>Option 1 - Proof from an Irish bank If you choose this option, you must bring an original statement from an Irish bank that shows a balance of €4,500 (or €700 per month if you are staying less than 6 months). The statement must be for an account in your own name, i.e. the same name as in your passport. You must also present a Mini Bank Statement, printed from an ATM, dated the day you present to Immigration if you choose this option.</p> <p>Option 2 - Proof from a foreign bank If you choose this option, you must bring 2 original bank statements from a foreign bank.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The first statement must show a balance of €4,500 (or €700 per month if you are staying less than 6 months). The statement must be less than 1 month old. • The second statement must be from the same bank. It must be less than 6 months old. • Proof of funds to be converted to euro on day of immigration appointment. To do that, go to an exchange webpage (for example: www.xe.com) to convert local currency to euro and print it out. <p>Both statements must be for the same account and in your own name, i.e. the same name as in your passport. You must also show that you have a debit card (for cash withdrawals in Ireland). The debit card must be for the same bank account that has the €4,500 (or €700 per month if you are staying less than 6 months).</p> <p>Option 3 - Proof from a financial services company If you choose this option, you must bring an original letter from a financial services company in Ireland that shows it holds €4,500 'in trust' for you (or €700 per month if you are staying less than 6 months). The financial services company must be regulated in Ireland by the Central Bank of Ireland.</p> <p>Option 4 - Proof via a pre-paid credit card or debit card If you choose this option, you must bring an original statement that you have a pre-paid credit card(s) or debit card(s) with €4,500 (or €700 per month if you are staying less than 6 months).</p> <p>Scholarship/Sponsored Students Students in receipt of a scholarship which either part funds or fully funds both their course fees and living costs must provide a letter, issued to them by the relevant organisation confirming they are the recipient of a scholarship, and what it covers.</p>

Funding Requirements for Non-EEA Students at First Registration from 1 July 2023

Non-EEA Students studying for a period of less than 6 months:	€700 per month of stay or €4,500 whichever is the lesser
Non-EEA Students studying for a period equal to or greater than 6 months up to 1 year	€4,500

Please remember that you are a guest in Ireland and the issuing of your Irish Residence Permit Card is at the discretion of the Irish government.
